## SPONSORING A PILGRIM AND YOU

Trusting in God for everything in our lives can seem daunting. From how our day will go, who we come in contact with and scheduling activities that we will be a part of.

Trust GOD from the bottom of your heart; don't try to figure out everything on

your own. Listen for GOD's voice in everything you do, everywhere you go; he's the one who will keep you on track. Don't assume that you know it all. Proverbs 3:5-6 (The Message)

We talk continuously about the importance of sponsorship and what being a good sponsor is. Without sponsors to sponsor pilgrims we do not have walks. Each one of us needs to follow the leading of the Lord in sponsoring a pilgrim or be praying for who God wants us to sponsor. We need to be intentional about sponsoring, this is how our community grows.

During my time as Registrar and providing Sponsorship training for pilgrims at a Pio Party, one thing remained constant.....God is always in charge and in control. It always amazed me how God was intentional when HE knew the time was right for a pilgrim to attend a walk weekend.

When sponsors talk to prospective pilgrims about attending a Walk to Emmaus weekend.....the conversation should be what your walk meant you, praying for the prospective pilgrim, are they interested in more information and is God leading them to attend a walk weekend. Notice the emphasis, a walk weekend, not a specific walk weekend.

God knows what is going on — all the hows, whens and whys. When you do not know what to do or what will happen next, trust that He does. Follow God's guidelines and commands knowing that as you practice obedience, He is working out the rest. "The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in Him, and He helps me. My heart leaps for joy, and with my song I praise Him" (Psalm 28:7, NIV).

Trust in God timing, for HE knows when the right time is for every pilgrim to attend a Walk to Emmaus weekend.


